1998 notes : based on short visit on 05 June, and then on observations 24 August onwards

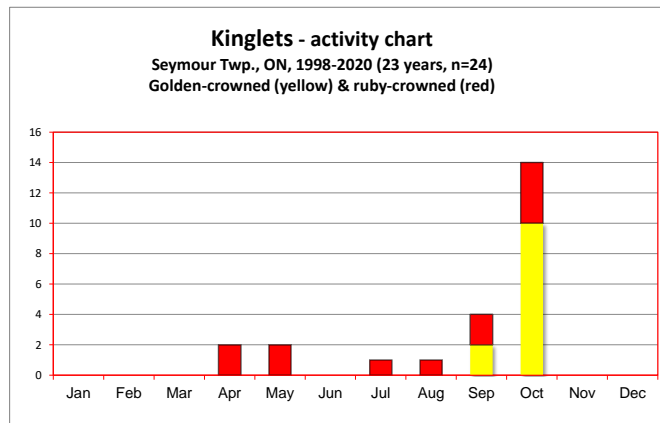

Pink: kinglets seen, sp. uncertain ?

Likely bird strikes at home: none.

Note: the chart displays the number of days in a given month in which the species were seen. On any given day, an individual or a small flock of birds were seen. Due to their small size and fleeting appearance, on 18 other days in this period, in 12 of the 23 years, one or more kinglets were noted in the township, but the species was not determined. Incidences per year: 1, 1, 2, 3, 1, 2, 2, 1, 2, 1, 1, 1 (n=18).
