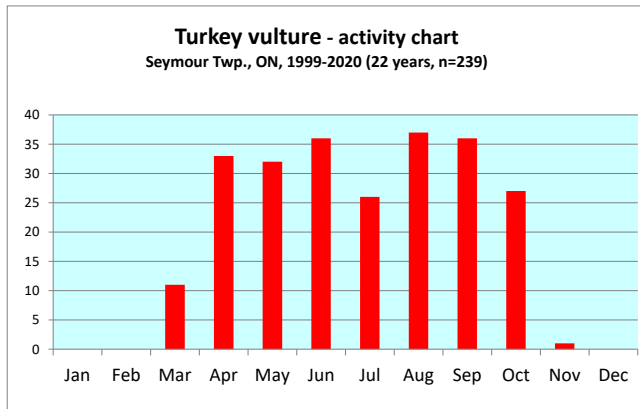
Likely HW bird strikes at home - none

Updated to 22 March 2021

Note: the chart displays the number of days in a given month in which the species was seen. This says nothing of total bird numbers: though commonly with this species one sees an individual or a pair in a day. This is a minimum, as the observer was not present continuously (some multi-week absences in some years), not observing from dawn to dusk, and not necessarily near the best feeding and roosting sites for the species.
